



substitute for the use of professionally trained medical personnel. Certificati American Red Cross "First Aid and Personal Safety Course" is highly recomm laying experience and knowledge in the proper use of a defibrillator(AED) and CPR car

NOTE: If a victim is seriously injured or ill, immediately call 911. If there is a large-scale risis or emergency that affects the surrounding area, it may take some time before EMS, Police or Fire can respond. That is why it is important to have qualified personne

- Treat the most dangerous and life-threatening condition first, reme Four (4) B's: breathing, bleeding, broken bones, burns
 Stay calm, try to keep the victim calm
- possibility of a head, neck, or back injury
- . If the victim is not alert, remember to check the ABCs A-airway, B-breathing
- Wash hands thoroughly before and after administering first aid
 Maintain a basic "First Aid Kit" with all the necessary supplies, i.e., bandages antiseptic ointment, aspirin/pain reliever, alcohol, hydrogen peroxide, soap, water
- antospic contribute, aspiritupam releaver, account, rystogem personae, soup, was sterile gauze pads, latex gloves, protective mask, medical scissors, cotton balls, moist towelettes, tape, and an AED located in an accessible area Designate a location for EMS to triage serious injuries

- wound. It may be necessary to add another layer of cloth to the wound. Maintain pressure for approximately five minutes. Elevate bleeding arm or leg unless a fracture
- blisters or remove clothes stuck to skin
- victim is conscious use "Heimlich Maneuver," stand behind victim and wrap your arms around victim's waist. Grasp your fist with the other hand and press into the victim's abdomen with a quick upward thrust. If the victim has collapsed and cannot be lifted, apply direct pressure with the heel of your hand to victim's abdomen and ush with quick upper thrust. Repeat if necessary
- Note: Different procedures apply for children
- Shock Indicators: pale, clammy skin; weakened c
- Fainting If the individual is weak and ready to faint, prevent them from falling. Help them to sit down by placing their head between their knees. Loosen tight clothing. If the individual has fainted, try to position him or her on their back with legs elevated above the level of the heart. If the victim vomits, turn the victim on their side to let drain from their mouth. If breathing stops, initiate CPR, call 911
